Kurmond Public School seeks to constantly provide high standards of education, self-esteem and safety for all its students. As decided by Parents & Citizens and Staff members, the wearing of uniform is integral to providing and maintaining these standards.

It is the intention of the school community that every student will be able to wear the correct school uniform at all times. Many community judgments are based on appearance and we urge parents to assist in creating and maintaining the highest possible impression of Kurmond Public School.

Uniform purchases may be made from the School Uniform Shop at the advertised time on Mondays and Wednesdays from 2.45pm-3.15pm. If you are unable to make these times, order forms are available at the office.

GROOMING:

Jewellery:	 The school maintains a definite policy on the wearing of jewellery by our students. The only items considered acceptable are: Watches Earrings: sleepers/studs Medical alert bracelet/necklace 	
Hair:	Hair should be clean, neat and appropriate to the school environment. Long hair should be tied back.	
Make-up:	No make-up or nail polish is permitted at school.	

Students are expected to have **all** items of clothing, **labelled** to assist with the return of lost items.
