CPR HELP is an exciting & rewarding Safety Awareness program that is aimed to educate young children from Kindergarten - Year 6 with basic techniques for First Aid and CPR. The children will gain knowledge of the **DRSABCD** Management procedures (Danger, Response, Send for Help, Airway, Breathing, CPR and Defibrillator).

Children will be involved in making the emergency phone call "000", answering questions asked by an operator and discussions of the importance of knowing their personal details/location. Children will learn step by step techniques of the Recovery Position. *By knowing how to put someone into the recovery position is a potential life saver.* Yrs 3-6 children will experience hands on techniques using manikins that will involve compressions and breathing.

It is important for these skills to be reinforced and updated yearly.

This will be a rewarding experience not to be missed. The program is conducted during school hours for approximately 1hr for K-2 and 1½hrs for Yrs 3-6 . All children will receive a special participation award.
