CPR HELP is an exciting and rewarding Safety Awareness program that is aimed to educate young children from Kindergarten - Year 6 with basic techniques for First Aid and CPR. The students will gain knowledge of the **DRSABCD** Management procedures (**D**anger, **R**esponse, **S**end for Help, **A**irway, **B**reathing, **C**PR and **D**efibrillator).

Students will be involved in making the emergency phone call "000", answering questions asked by an operator and discussions of the importance of knowing their personal details/location. Students will learn step by step techniques of the Stable Position. *By knowing how to put someone into the stable position is a potential life saver.* Years 3-6 students will experience hands on techniques using manikins that will involve compressions and breathing.

"It's better to know it and not need it, than need it and not know it"

This will be a rewarding experience not to be missed. The program is conducted during school hours for approximately 1hr for K-2 and 1½hrs for Years 3-6. All students will receive a special participation award.
