2019 SWIMMING CARNIVAL

Event: Kurmond Public School Swimming Carnival. <u>ALL</u> students in Years 3 – 6 are

expected to attend the Carnival.

Venue: Richmond Swimming Pool

Date: Tuesday 12th February 2019

<u>Time</u>: 9.15 am - 2.30 pm

<u>Travel</u>: Bus - leaves school at 9.15 am Bus - returns to school by 3.00 pm

Cost: \$16.00 for bus travellers - covers cost of bus, pool entry and pool hire (to be paid

through school prior to carnival)

OR

\$8.00 for car travellers - covers pool entry and pool hire (to be paid through school prior to carnival). Students must be at the pool by 9.30 am. Parents must be at the pool for return pick up by 2.15 pm.

*Concession tickets cannot be used. Spectator admission fees of \$1 will be charged at

the gate.

Bring: Hat, sunscreen, sleeved shirt (T-shirts in house colours or sports uniform - NO

singlet tops), drink bottle, recess, lunch, swimmers, towel, plastic bag for wet clothing

* Children will be responsible for applying own sunscreen

<u>Carnival</u>: • 8 - 12 year old swimmers - competitive events and possible house relays (final

places based on times - no finals)

• Years 3 - 6 non-swimmers only – shallow-end races, including kickboard races - adult

support will be available

Parents may pay by cash or cheque or make **online payments** using Visa or MasterCard credit or debit cards. Just go to the school website https://kurmond-p.schools.nsw.gov.au/contact-us.html and click on 'Make a Payment' and complete the mandatory fields, i.e. those shown with *, using 'Swimming Carnival' as the reference. Return the permission note the next day with the online section completed.

Notes must be returned and events entered by Wednesday 6th February. Medley swimmers must compete in the individual 50m freestyle, back, breast and butterfly strokes before entering. The 100m freestyle is an open age event. District representation in all races depends on qualifying times, not places.

Students will be sitting in house groups. Parents wishing to sit with their children must sit in the appropriate house areas. Children will **not** be allowed to sit with parents away from their house groups.

<u>Please note</u>: 8-year-old Year 2 2019 students may only attend if they can competently swim in 50m events and are willing to compete at District Carnival level, if they qualify. <u>There will be NO novelty races or shallow-end races for Yr 2 2019 students</u>. Non-competing Yr 2 2019 students are NOT to attend as spectators, they are to attend school as usual.

8 YEAR OLD SWIMMERS IN YEAR 2 IN 2019

All students in *Years* 3 – 6 in 2019 are expected to attend the school swimming carnival to be held on Tuesday 12th February. Students in *Kindergarten* – *Year* 2 in 2019 are required to attend school as usual.

However, if a Year 2 child:

- (a) turns 8 years old in 2019 AND
- (b) is a <u>competent swimmer</u> (can jump/dive in deep end and <u>swim 50m</u> using <u>correct stroke</u>) <u>AND</u>
- (c) is prepared to compete at District Carnival (if they qualify),

then arrangements will be made for them to compete at the school carnival. Please ask at the office for a permission note.

<u>Note</u>: Qualifying times for District Carnival are very generous and students who qualify <u>will be required</u> to compete at District level.

• Eight year old Year 2 2019 students will not be allowed to swim in novelty events.
